

DORM PACKING CHECKLIST

To help you plan for a great year living in the boys' or girls' dorm, the following is a list of things you will probably need, as well as some things you need to leave at home.

We have a Wal-Mart and other shopping areas nearby to pick up other necessities when you arrive, if needed.

BEDDING

- Twin (single) mattress cover
- Twin (single) sheets
- Pillow
- Twin blanket
- Twin bed spread or comforter



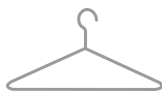
BATH

- Shower flip flops
- Bath towels / washcloth
- Toiletry items – shampoo, body soap, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.



DORM ROOM

- Laundry basket
- Laundry soap (NO LIQUID BLEACH)
- Clothes hangers
- Battery operated alarm clock
- Trash can
- Small desk lamp
- Headphones (this is the ONLY way to listen to any electronic device or your computer)
- Power strip surge protector
- Cleaning supplies
- Small fan for the hot days
- Bible
- Any medication/first aid supplies you may need
- Command hooks – these are the only hooks you may use on your walls (No holes are to be made in the walls from hooks, nails, stick pins, push pins, screws, etc.)



SCHOOL SUPPLIES

- Paper
- Pens/pencils
- 3-ring note books
- Daily planner for tracking homework
- Backpack
- USB flash drive
- TI-83 or TI-84 graphing calculator (preferred) for math classes.
- A translator (cell phones are not allowed in class) *International students only.*



EXTRAS YOU MIGHT WANT TO BRING

- Helmet if you are bringing a bike or skateboard
- Books to read
- Curtains
 - BOYS DORM = No curtains allowed
 - GIRLS DORM = room windows are 98" wide X 53" tall. If you want to bring curtains be sure to bring your own tension rod. No rods are provided. (No additional holes may be put into the wall)
- Microwave
- Small fridge
- Iron
- Personal items to make your room feel more like home (family pictures, etc.)
- Sealable plastic containers for any snacks you bring
- Computer
- Cell phone (AT&T is the best cell service)
- Shower caddy/basket to carry your shower supplies
- Umbrella
- Sleeping bag (for overnight trips)
